- 1- The project has to need, some time, the citizen participation to generate new Knowledge.
- 2- The citizens have to participate minimum in one of this 4 things: collecting data, to interpreting data, to defining problems/objectives/challenges or designing the research
- 3- The action area of the project has to be in the immediate environment of the citizen (it can be a negotiable condition)
- 4- The participant citizens has to share and promote the project and the citizen science.
- 5- The project has to inform the participant citizens especially with the results and the conclusions.
- 6- The project has to follow the behavior guideline noticeable in the RRI from the UE once it's time to bring the project and the results closer to the citizens.
- 7- The project has to have an ethic that fits in the free code, open data and license Creative Commons.
- 8- The participants are involved in finding digital tool or easy sustainable experiments.
- 9- The participants are involved on the creation of a friendly environment, cooperative without competition.
- 10- The project should have a social and socio-environmental impact.
